Coho Kids Time has been proudly serving the Ballard area since 1999, providing quality, licensed childcare for

children ages 5-12. We are located at Salmon Bay School and provide care for children from other local Elementary Schools: Adams, Loyal Heights, North Beach, Whittier, West Woodland and Lowell (school bus transportation from Lowell, all the rest have van pick up). Our programs include before and after school care, full day care during school breaks, and an amazing summer camp.

### Programs:

**Before School:** 7:00 am to 9:00 am  
Children are escorted to their busses or vans at specified times.

**After School:** 2:35 pm to 6:00 pm  
Children find their way from Salmon Bay classes, get dropped off by vans from Ballard Boys and Girls Club, or get picked up from bus stops by staff.

### Group Structure:

**Before School:** all ages are in the Main Room.

**After School:** grades K-2 are in the Main Room.

Grades 3-5 are in the Big Kids Room (room 109).

## Program Schedules

### Before School

7:00 am to 8:30 am Children work on homework, play games, read or do small arts and crafts projects.

8:00 am Snack is served (schedule posted on parent bulletin board)

8:20 am Salmon Bay students head to class, students from all other schools get cleaned up and ready to go.

### After School

2:40 pm Children arrive from their classes.  
Snack is served.

3:20 pm Outside or gym opens up for group games. Choice of activities in the room.

4:00 pm Homework and reading time.

4:30 pm Project of the day! Check the weekly schedule for daily activity, it could be science, cooking, arts and crafts!

4:45 pm Gym or outside opens up for group games. Project of the day, or a quiet choice activity.

5:00 pm Big Kids move over to main room. Activities are free choice, finishing up projects or homework, computers open.

6:00 pm Coho Kids Time is closed.

## Program Schedules

### Full Day Care

We offer full day care during almost all school breaks. During these days we are open from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm. Your child must bring a lunch from home. On full days from approximately 10:00 am to 4:00 pm we will be gone on a field trip. Sign-up for any full days will be on the parent counter 2 weeks before the full day or break starts.
